


Ovipets breeding guide

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Dedicated to new fans and players of Ovipet. It is not always easy to start being a new member of the Ovipet Society. To get started, in a good direction, you might want to head over to the adoption center, so you can choose your pets to breed with, and start a new Ovi family. Make sure to choose pets from the adoption center wisely, you can only adopt one pet every ten minutes. Once you've taken your pet (s), why don't you head for more than an English band. You can ask around for some pets. There are some good people known for Ovipets who can even donate to pets, too. If you have pets you want to breed with, go visit them at your home. You should only have one tab to start with, so finding your pets should be easy. You will need one female and one male pet of the same species to breed. Click on any pet, and at the bottom should be a clickable button that says: Diluting Click that and you should see your other pet listed there. Clcik him/her and he will say: Are you sure you want to divorce kew? Click normally. Once you have successfully bred pets, an egg should appear. You have to turn this egg every day for a quick hatching. This is it, your own family. The Ovie. Don't worry, your females won't be unavailable for breeding with forever. In a fair amount of time, you should be able to breed it again. OviaAddict P.S. If you're wondering what my user is on Ovipets, I'm a midnight Vulpe breeder. You can find me in a group called Clan Revival Breeding is the most important part of the game. As the breed Edit Breed of two pets, they should be: The same species one male and one female female that has not been bred for a while are not bound for three generations After breeding Edit You will get an egg after breeding, which must be turned 4 times until it can hatch. The egg can be rotated by singing to your or someone else's hatchery by clicking on the egg and pressing the green arrows button. The time between one turn and the other depends on the view. When it reaches 100% you can hatch an egg. This has to be done manually - it doesn't happen automatically - and done just like turning an egg. The pet will stay in the incubator until you give it a name. Offspring will inherit colors and mutations from parents. Colors can be seen on the egg, mutations will be shown on hatched pets or if you do a DNA profile. The species must be examined to level 5 in order to make a DNA profile. You can also splice the eggs to get a new mutation for offspring. Warning: Pets can starve in an incubator and eggs that have not hatched for ten will spoil. Hint: If you let someone else turn your eggs, they may find credit for the reward. People who usually do this are called egg ninjas. They can't reproduce with each other. View the pedigree chart of both pets. If any of the visible ancestors are the same in both pets, they are related. Ovipets is a pet game involving creating or continuing the pedigree. This may include, but is not limited to breeding project pets, which are usually spliced and painted to represent a specific theme or idea, trying to create specific colors in which the site is classified as clean, or simply breeding two pets of the same species. My opinion? I'd rate it 8.5/10. I'm never too interested in a paid and unpaid separation, but it's actually quite reasonable on this site, if you're trading money for loans as low as \$5, you'll permanently have the benefits of a paid member. No periodic payments are required. Species and genetic diversity within the species are good, which is with a huge range of colors and mutations. There's also going on a lot of ways you can go on in the game. I don't like that you need to sign up with their facebook account while it's relatively convenient, it limits a lot of movements and, let's not do it too personal, but I don't like the probing nature of Facebook. When you join the site, you will see a lot of tabs-what are they for? The first tab presented by the icon you selected is the presentation tab. It includes your name, profile picture, achievements, group, friends and presentation, as well as a button to write to your channel, which will be developed later. Your name can be edited and reserved, and your profile picture can be changed, but I'll establish it later. Achievements represent specific achievements in the game to help you, here is a list of all the achievements that happen to exist. They will be automatically rewarded when you reach the requirements. There is no reward for getting achievements. Groups are places where members of the Ovipet community can meet on similar grounds. For your first groups, I suggest joining groups representative of any of your spoken languages, and breed for free. There is no limit to the number of groups that a player can own, admin or join. To view the groups, click the Group View button. Then this display will appear. The tab you are currently showing shows all the groups you are a member of. Use the rooms in the bottom left corner to navigate the menu. The text titled Groups also find out whether you are a member, administrator or owner. If you have a group, you'll see an additional tab showing all your groups. If you are invited to a private group, it will appear in the invitation tab. You have to go to the group page to join. To create a group, select the Create Group tab. Then it will take you to this page. You have to enter an unused group name, and you can write a basic description of your group in the description box. Creating a group has two requirements - you have to be a paid member and you must have 30 credits from which to be used to create a group. I note that after the update, each administrator must have ten members in the group. If the administrator is the administrator, while the group has ten members, but the number decreases, the administrator will not be demoted. Next, we'll discuss your friends. If you have friends on Facebook who play Ovipets, they will be automatically added to the friends list when you start the game. Otherwise, you can send or receive requests to receive friends. The number of friends that players may have is not limited. To view your friends, simply click the Show Friends button below the display of your friends list. You can view which of your friends is online in the online tab, view all your friends in the friends tab, and look at new friend requests in the friends tab requests. To accept a friend's request, click on the person's icon and go to their page. Then you'll see a few buttons. (name cleared to protect the user's identity). Just click to accept the request of friends. If you don't want to be friends with Click the request view. They will still be able to interact with you. If you don't want to interact with someone, you can press the user's block button. The user's blocking will have the following effects: Next is your presentation. It's a significant place of self-expression. As you can see in my my I've listed a decent amount of information about myself. My username is Bismuth (ignore the Russian language, that's just I'm starting to translate). I list that I don't have any rules and that I'm the administrator of several groups. This allows people to know minimal information about me before submitting a friend request. You can also format the presentation with bbcode, which is what I used to make orange, bold, centered text. That's all the bbcode I currently know. Comment below if a link needs to be added. (clrColor) (clr) Replace the Color color of your choice. Your feed is where you are barraged with posts by everyone you are friends with, personal messages, ovipets, and messages in the groups you are a member of. You can filter through what messages you see through the top bar. You can also filter whether you see the most recent posts that are just recently made, or the latest change that are posts that are either recently made or most recently commented on. I only show your messages. Users only show messages made by users like you and your friends. You won't see messages made by groups or Ovipets. Pets only shows automatic messages involving pets such as breeding or adoption. You won't see messages that are intentionally written and made by users. Private shows are the only messages that have been sent privately to you, regardless of whether it is a deliberate message or a trade/friend request. The likes show messages you liked using the l. Group button shows only messages that people have made to the group. Any message you've made is considered part of your feed profile that people will specifically view when they click on your page-such messages are ignored in this section. News shows messages made by the official Ovipets psuedoaccount. Next is the tab of your pets. Pets where you can view all your named pets. You can arrange them in enclosures. In your tabs, you have several options that can be viewed and selected from at the bottom of the tab (relatively uncomfortable if you have a lot of pets.) Mass Feed allows All pets in the credit tab, depending on the number of pets in the tab. Adding a case allows you to create a new case. Renaming the case allows you to rename the case. Remove the case allows you to remove the case. Pets inside the enclosure will not be removed, but will be moved to different tabs. Sorting allows you to sort Characteristics. He doesn't rule out pets. The filter also allows you to sort pets by characteristics, but this excludes pets. If any of the pets in your tab are starving, mass feed Starving will appear at the top of the tab along with the usual Mass Feed button. It will feed any pets whose hunger is below a certain percentage. Mass food starving also requires credits for use. You can tell if the pet is starving while looking at the border around the image of the pet when you are viewing the enclosures. If it's red, they're starving. If it's blue, they're above the starving threshold. I would also like to point out that if you want to change the pet enclosure, you can do so by dragging and dropping them into the enclosure of your choice. Recently, a mass choice option was added. To activate the mass, select, hold the left click on the animal. He then selects the pet, highlighting them in green, and you can click to choose any pets. At the bottom of the tab are the buttons to drop and send to ac, and at the top of the tab tag and move to the case tab. Now let's take a look at the pet profile page. As you can see, there is a lot of information about the pet on its profile page. His name appears on the absolute top, in the blue bar. Underneath it is a small section. There is a female symbol indicating that the pet is feminine, and the pink dot. The pink dot means it is a pure pet. Pure pets are pets with a certain color, which is considered clean on the site, and are often in demand, depending on the rarity of pure color. Here are all available clean colors. Mutations show what variations appear on the pet. They are genetically transmitted and can be splicing, and dominance can be seen in the research tab. Punchett squares work great if you're trying to breed for something specific! You feed your pets for free by simply manually clicking the feed button on your page. Different pets need to be fed at different intervals, as follows: Avi – 16 days Canis – 25 days Catus – 20 days Cebidae – 25 days Cetacea – 30 days Chiropy – 25 days Draconis – 30 days Equus – 30 days Feline – 20 days Gallus – 20 days Gekko – 20 days Gryphus – 25 days Haliaeetus – 25 days Lepus – 20 days Lotor – 20 days Lupus – 25 days Macropus – 30 days Mustela – 20 days Ovis – 30 days Pacos – 30 days Piscium – 15 days Psittaco – 25 days Rangifier – 35 days Raptor – 30 days Rattus – 18 days Serpentes – 20 days Struthio – 35 days Ursa – 35 days Vulpes – 30 days The overview displays basic information about the pet, and shows anyone who may have previously owned it. You can also see if someone loved your pet. You can view your pet's pedigree in the pedigree tab. Here I must point out that pets are considered unrelated and therefore able to reproduce as long as their parents, grandparents, and great-grandmothers and great-grandmothers are not related. All the past that can be connected. You can breed two pets in the breeding tab. You need to choose an aviary and then just click on the pet from which you would like to breed. This will automatically lead you to a freshly lit egg, of which I will cover later. I note here that while males can reproduce an unlimited number of times, females can reproduce once until their cooling reproduction stops. I listed below all the breeding cooling. You can sterilize the pet, which will forever prevent any breeding or cloning of the specified pet at the expense of 10 credits. You can't, however, splice an adult pet that is reserved for unhatched eggs. Last but not least, the editing tab. The editing tab carries most of the control you have over your pet. Trading is what either sell or put a pet up for adoption. Just click on the trade button and you can make one of the following: If you don't set the value to anything, people can make an offer and send trading requests. You'll have to decide whether to opt out or accept. If you set the trading value on any natural number, people will automatically be able to do credit transactions to buy a pet. If you set the trading value to 0, people will be able to automatically accept your pet and it will appear as a symbol of taking home instead of trading coins. The breed allows other people to reproduce with your pet. There are several options. If you do not enter any nutritional value of the transaction, they will send an offer and you can manually refuse or accept. If you set the trade value to a natural number, people will automatically be able to complete the transaction and breed with your pet. If you set the trade value to 0, people will be able to automatically breed with your pet for free. You can change the pet enclosure in the enclosure menu, scroll through the list and click that of your choice. Eggs and unnamed pets are stored in the incubator. Eggs are shown in rows 7, and go through four phases to hatch. In order for the egg to hatch, they must be turned into each phase - 0%, 25%, 50%, and 75%. You can turn the eggs, but you won't get credits. If other users turn your eggs, they have a chance to accidentally get one credit every time they turn an egg. When the egg rotates, it will eventually pass through the percentages until it reaches the next turning percentage. Once it is 100%, the egg can be hatched. Eggs take a different amount of time depending on the type of hatch, although the interval between the egg rotation is specific. Just click on the egg page and click the hatch egg button. When the egg hatches, it will be moved under the eggs in the division of unnamed pets. Nameless pets cannot be fed or bred, but they can be exchanged. When you click on your pet and enter the name, they will be placed in your unsorted tab. Next is the trading tab. It shows your trades with other users, credit transactions, and allows you to purchase credits and/or Ovi. Transactions with other users can lead to the exchange of credits, pets, eggs and breeders. Unpaid users can't send credits. The list under the deals shows all the credit transactions, and the arrows that allow you to flip back and forth. This is useful when you track income and results. Get more credits allows you to buy loans in real currency, and subscription to Ovi allows you to purchase a subscription to Ovi, which includes halving in half Hatching time, eliminates the feeding timer, and more. Next is the study tab, presented by a string of DNA. You will see all the species that you have explored and the ones you don't have. Some species, such as draconian and fir, require that the specimen belongs before you can explore them. When you've researched the species, you can start researching levels (which give a benefit to this species, such as lower generation cost), splicing studies that can be applied to eggs, or generate members of that species. When an animal is generated, you will choose, as a rule, its colors and gender. The colors will not be completely accurate when the animal is generated, but they will be somewhat similar. Unpaid users cannot explore the fifth level of the species. Lock colors can help the user get more color accuracy, especially with regard to the generation of pure. Here are the colors of the lock for each pure color: (create a set for each castle) white: lock red/ green / blue siVer: n/a, should be the same for all geniuses of pets gray: n/a, should be the same for all geniuses pets black: castle red / green / blue brown: castle blue burgundy: castle green / blue red: castle red / blue bronze: castle red / blue gold: castle red / blue yellow: castle red / green / olive blue: castle blue green: castle red/ green / blue emerald: castle red / blue Emerald: Castle Red/Blue Red/Blue Teal: Castle Red Diamond: Castle Blue: Castle Red/Green/Blue: Castle Red/Green Fleet: Castle Red/Green Violet: Castle Green Purple: Castle Red/Green/Blue Pink: Castle Red (I Can't Currently Find Resource for All Clean Colors) And Castles for Gems : peridot: castle red/blue amethyst: castle green/blue pearls: castle red/ green jade: castle red agate: castle red / blue aquamarine: castle red onyx: n/a amber: castle red / blue alexandrite: n/a sapphire: castle red / green / blue opal: castle red / blue Assuming that you create two pedigrees from a born pet, as long as there is only one to the left of each line, the pets generated will disappear from the pedigree and the pets you have created will be considered an unrelated-concept that is the basis of the project solutions. Next is the Adoption Center, represented by a paw on the right side of the page. The adoption center displays a random assortment of pets that have been sent to the air conditioner by various Ovipets users-while many are starving while waiting for adoption, these are pets that have been successful in reaching the AC page. If the animal is not taken for some time Time, it will be placed back in the AC storage and will not be available for adoption again if it is not lucky enough to be displayed twice. You can take one pet every ten minutes. In the middle on the right is the auction center, represented by the dal. An auction center where users can sell collections of objects and buyers can easily view all available auctions. To create an auction, there are specifications that need to be filled. It also requires a fee of 20 credits and that the user setting up the auction is paid. Unpaid users cannot bid at auctions. Finally, it's a search feature represented by a magnifying glass. It can be used to look through all the pet species in your group of friends, a particular group, through pets, through pets that you liked, through users, through groups, and to find friends. When trying to purchase the cheapest or best selection of pets, I suggest installing a search to look through breed free. The group is very large and very active and I find it the second best group, crashing only in English (unfortunately not available to search through). If your pets have died, you can spice them up for a fee 1 credit by searching through my pets and clicking search for the dead. This will allow you to see all of your dead pets presented as gray and they can be revived by clicking on them to access your page and pressing the resurrection button. If you're using a friend finder, you'll be shown to other users who have been using a friend finder for a period of time. Last but not least, this is the top bar of the web page ovipets. This displays a search bar that will display any of the following that will display any of the following that share the characteristics of what you typed: your pets, your friends, and any group. If you click on a username or icon, you'll be returned to your profile page. If you click on your profile, you can change your account settings. There is also a login bonus that is provided from time to time if you log in every day. You can check the timer to see if you qualify for the award by simply clicking on the profile and checking. Logout lets you log out of your Ovipets account and returns you to the default page.
